OWI Requirements

lowa requires that OWI offenders successfully complete a course for drinking drivers, and a substance abuse evaluation. Non-lowans who offend in lowa may complete these requirements in another state.

You will need to submit a certificate or letter of completion from the education program which clearly specifies the name of the agency providing the education and its location, the number of hours of the course, and the date the course was completed. The course MUST be a <u>state approved program</u> and at least 8 hours in length. If your course was not at least 8 hours in length, you will need additional education so that the total equals at least 8 hours. **Treatment will not be accepted in lieu of education**. <u>Please note that on-line classes will not be accepted</u>.

You will also need to provide documentation of a substance abuse evaluation/assessment which clearly specifies the date of the evaluation, the name of the evaluator/agency, the evaluator's recommendation, the evaluator/agency's location/telephone number. If the evaluation recommends treatment, documentation showing when and where the treatment was completed must also be submitted.
