Analysis by headspace gas chromatography has revealed an ethyl alcohol concentration to be 0.032 ± 0.002 grams/100mL of blood at 99.73% level of confidence.

The above toxicological analyses were completed on Item 1, which was labeled as a sample from Makenna Streff.

The DCI Criminalistics Laboratory is currently performing confirmational analysis on blood samples for following drugs: alcohol, amphetamines, cannabinoids, morphine, oxycodone, codeine, methadone, oxycodone, hydrocodone, hydromorphone, phenazepam, 7-aminoflunitrazepam, 7-aminoclonazepam, midazolam, a-OH alprazolam, chlordiazepoxide, nordiazepam, lorazepam, oxazepam, clonazepam, alprazolam, triazolam, temazepam, diazepam, etizolam, flualprazolam, PCP, tramadol, amitriptyline, quetiapine, doxepin, imipramine, nortriptyline, cyclobenzaprine, dextromethorphan, 6-acetylmorphine, fentanyl, acetylfentanyl, zolpidem, cocaine (metabolites), buprenorphine, and norbuprenorphine. Positive screens for barbiturates should be considered presumptive and it is recommended that the sample be sent to a private laboratory to confirm the presence in the sample. Arrangements and expenses for sending the sample to a private laboratory must be made by the submitting agency and not the DCI Laboratory.
